The town board of the Town of West Point held their regular monthly meeting on Thursday - September 6, 1990 at 8:00 p.m. at the town hall. The members present were: John Benish-Chairman, Fred Thistle-1st Supervisor, A. Dave Cole-2nd Supervisor, Edith Eberle-Clerk, Joan Bader-Treasurer and Harry Sawyer-Assessor.

The meeting was published in the Lodi Enterprise and the Sauk Prairie Star and posted in four places.

The minutes were read from the August 9th meeting, a motion was made by Fred Thistle to approve the minutes, 2nd by Dave Cole - motion carried.

The treasurers report was as follows: General - \$79,324.97 and Holding Tank - \$774.34; a motion was made by Fred Thistle to approve the treasurers report, 2nd by Dave Cole - motion carried.

The bills were presented and a motion was made by John Benish to pay the bills, 2nd by Fred Thistle - motion carried.

Cheri Marston from the Laub Group explained our policy to the town board. It was very helpful.

Cathy Lathrop is running to County Clerk - she introduced herself to the town board and explained why she felt she would make a good county clerk.

A motion was made by Dave Cole to have 3 election workers for the September 11 primary, 2nd by Fred Thistle - motion carried.

A motion was made by Fred Thistle to pay for the evening meal for the election workers, 2nd by Dave Cole - motion carried.

Someone had asked the town board to pay for putting gravel on Rausch Lane, the town board will not put gravel on Rausch Lane because it is not a town road.

There was no decision made about the rocks in the public access in Alray.

There will be a special town board meeting on Wednesday, September 12, at 7:30 p.m. at the town hall to decide what town roads need to be done yet this year.

A motion was made by Fred Thistle to borrow \$32,000.00 from the State Bank of Lodi for the closing of the Sanitary Landfill (making larger payments on the principal if possible), 2nd by John Benish - motion carried.
