

TOWN OF WEST POINT

The town board of the Town of West Point held their regular monthly meeting on Thursday - October 4, 1990 at 8:00 p.m. at the town hall. The members present were: John Benish-Chairman, Fred Thistle-1st Supervisor, A. Dave Cole-2nd Supervisor, Edith Eberle-Clerk, and Joan Bader-Treasurer. Harry Sawyer-Assessor was absent.

The meeting was published in the Lodi Enterprise and the Sauk Prairie Star and posted in four places.

A motion was made by Dave Cole to add Election to the agenda of tonight meeting, 2nd by Fred Thistle, motion carried.

The minutes were read from the September 6th meeting, a motion was made by Fred Thistle to approve the minutes, 2nd by Dave Cole, motion carried.

The minutes were read from the September 12th meeting, a motion was made by Dave Cole to approve the minutes, 2nd by Fred Thistle, motion carried.

The minutes were read from the September 20th meeting, a motion was made by Dave Cole to approve the minutes, 2nd by John Benish, motion carried.

The treasurer's report was as follows: General - \$27,771.86 and the Holding Tank - \$774.34; a motion was made by Fred Thistle to approve the treasurers report, 2nd by John Benish, motion carried.

A letter from Wisconsin Department of Transportation asking the Town of West Point to give Terry Volk an occupancy agreement. A motion was made by Fred Thistle to grant Volk a ^{variance} ~~and~~ occupancy agreement ~~and~~ infringement ~~and~~ to the Wisconsin Department of Transportation, 2nd by John Benish, motion carried. The chairman is to write a letter to Wisconsin Department of Transportation explaining the Town of West Point view on this matter.

The bills were presented, a motion was made by Dave Cole to pay the bills presented, 2nd by Fred Thistle, motion carried.

Mr. George Schmidt appeared before the town board explaining why he felt that the town of West Point should help with the cost of having gravel on Rausch Lane. Chairman John Benish is to talk to the two land owners adjoining the road to see if a different road entrance could be worked out.

A resolution was presented asking Columbia County Solid Waste Committee for the January payment of the Recycling Funds to be used for a Recycling Building. A motion was made to approve this resolution by Fred Thistle, 2nd by John Benish, motion carried.

Dog Kennels were brought up to have one at the Town Chairman home and one at the 2nd Supervisor home to be used for the picking up of stray dogs. After some discussion - dog kennels were tabled until a later date.

A motion was made by Dave Cole to put a Transfer Site Building out on bids (the building would be 34' by 40' with a room insulated on one side of the building), 2nd by Fred Thistle, motion carried. The bid opening will be on Monday, October 22, 1990, at 7:45 p.m. at the town hall.

There was a complaint on a school bus going to fast in Trails End. After some discussion - a motion was made by Fred Thistle to amend Resolution 8-85 to a 25 mile per hour speed on Black Hawk Drive, Smith Park Road and all of Trails End, 2nd by Dave Cole, motion carried.

A motion was made by Dave Cole to have five (5) election workers at the November election and to also finish them with meals, 2nd by Fred Thistle - motion carried.

October 25th, 1990 was the date set for the budget meeting, the time at 7:00 p.m. at the town clerks home.

A motion was made by Fred Thistle to adjourn the meeting, 2nd by John Benish, motion carried.
