

TOWN OF WEST POINT

The town board of the Town of West Point held their regular monthly meeting on Thursday - November 8, 1990 at 8:00 p.m. at the town hall. The members present were: John Benish-Chairman, Fred Thistle-1st Supervisor, A. Dave Cole-2nd Supervisor, Edith Eberle-Clerk, Joan Bader-Treasurer, and Harry Sawyer-Assessor.

The meeting was published in the Lodi Enterprise and the Sauk Prairie Star and posted in four places.

Change to the agenda - Flag and Flag Pole and Transfer Site Bridge on Hwy. 113

The minutes were read from the October 4, 1990 meeting, a motion was made by Dave Cole to approve the minutes with correction, 2nd by Fred Thistle - motion carried.

The treasurers report was as follows: General - \$30,960.32; Holding Tank - \$774.34. A motion was made by Fred Thistle to approve the treasurers report, 2nd by John Benish - motion carried.

The bills were presented, a motion was made by Fred Thistle to pay the bills, 2nd by John Benish - motion carried.

Chairman John Benish stated that he didn't get one landowners permission to change the road going into Rausch Lane. After some discussion a motion was made by Dave Cole to have the town grade the Rausch Lane this fall at the towns expense and in the spring the town will gravel the road paying half the cost of the gravel and the landowners paying the other half of the cost of the gravel, and with no further expense to be paid by the Town of West Point, 2nd by Fred Thistle - motion carried.

A motion was made by Dave Cole to have eaves trough put on the North side of the town hall, 2nd by Fred Thistle - motion carried.

A motion was made by Dave Cole to have 3 people to work at the special election for Sauk Prairie School, 2nd by Fred Thistle - motion carried. Sauk Prairie School has to pay all costs of the election.

Bank was tabled until the special town meeting on November 14, 1990.

A motion was made by Dave Cole to go on record in favor of reconstruction of the bridge on Hwy. 113 over the railroad tracks, 2nd by John Benish - motion carried.

A motion was made to have the clerk order a flag for Transfer Site by Fred Thistle, 2nd by Dave Cole - motion carried.

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Chuck Zeman came before the town board and stated that the new fire truck will arrive the end of December, therefore the Lodi Fire Department will be billing the Town of West Point right after the first of January, 1991.

A motion was made by Fred Thistle to adjourn the meeting, 2nd by John Benish - motion carried.
