A motion was made by Fred Thistle to grant Pine Vista a Mobile Home Park License for 1991, 2nd by John Benish - motion carried.

A motion was made by John Benish to grant Schoeppps Cottonwood Resort a Mobile Home Park License for 1991, 2nd by Fred Thistle - motion carried.

There was a complaint of trash on Klamer Road - the board has taken a look at the property in question and decided that it was not a problem at this time as the house was just build and that landscaping has not yet be done.

Realtor Sue Pfiel, brought Neil and Sharon Walter, Roy Hermes and Patricia Pearson have who have purchased the Dave Wartner property with approximately 68 acres which are already zoned R-1; and approximately 80 acres which are zoned agricultural. They wanted the town boards opinion on the rezoning of the agricultural land to residential. The town board asked to have the ideas and plans with roads etc. brought back before the town board at a later date.
