

## TOWN OF WEST POINT

The town board of the Town of West Point held a special meeting on Friday, June 21, 1991 at 6:00 p.m. The members present were: John Benish-Chairman, Fred Thistle-1st Supervisor, A. Dave Cole-2nd Supervisor, and Edith Eberle-Clerk.

The meeting was published in the Lodi Enterprise and the Sauk Prairie Star and posted in four places.

The town board went out and inspected the following town roads, Chrisler Road, Van Ness Road, Golf Road, Gastrow Road, West Harmon Road, Schoepp Road, and Trails End then the town board returned to the town hall at 7:45 p.m. A motion was made by Fred Thistle to have 1.2 miles done on Golf Road, 2nd by Dave Cole - motion carried. A motion was made by Dave Cole to do 1 mile of West Harmon Road, 2nd by Fred Thistle - motion carried. A motion was made by Fred Thistle to have Scott Construction do Golf Road and Columbia County Highway do West Harmon Road, 2nd by John Benish, motion carried. A motion was made by Dave Cole to have the remainder of the Highway Construction Budget go into putting up barricades on Trails End, 2nd by Fred Thistle - motion carried. Also John Benish is to have Columbia County Highway engineer look and Trails End and give us a cost to do next year.

A motion by Fred Thistle to take a copy of the Town of Pacific sub division ordinance to our lawyer to compare the Town of Pacific Ordinance with Town of Lodi Ordinance and come up with an Ordinance for the Town of West Point, 2nd by John Benish - motion carried. Each town board member is to make an appointment to see Jeff Clark the town's attorney to explain their views on the two ordinances.

A motion was made by Dave Cole to have the Questionnaire on Land Use delivered to all residents in the town of West Point and have them returned by August 15, 1991, 2nd Fred Thistle - motion carried.

A motion was made by Fred Thistle to have Social Security take out of all employees of the Town of West Point but not Federal and State Taxes and to order new computer checks and check program for the town computer, 2nd by John Benish - motion carried.

Mr. Phillip Carrley came before the town board asking to put a pier on public access on Lake Drive - after discussion Mr. Carrley will have to do some checking in to the liability etc. and come back to the town board at a later date.

A motion was made by Fred Thistle to adjourn the meeting at 9:00 p.m., 2nd by John Benish - motion carried.
