

TOWN OF WEST POINT

The special meeting was held on Thursday, January 9, 1992 at 7:00 p.m. at the town hall. All town board members were present and the surveyor and engineer for Lake Wisconsin Ferry View Acres Subdivision and town of West Point engineer was also present. New plans were presented and discussed between the town board and the surveyor and engineer's for both parties about questions and concerns each had. The concerns the town board had was drainage by the road, \$8,000.00 for a culvert, and thickness of road material. There was no final approval made at this time. The special meeting adjourned at 8:00 p.m.

The regular meeting was called to order at 8:00 p.m. The members present were: John Benish-Chairman, Fred Thistle-1st Supervisor, Dave Cole-2nd Supervisor, Edith Eberle-Clerk, Joan Bader-Treasurer, and Harry Sawyer-Assessor.

The meeting was published in the Lodi Enterprise and the Sauk Prairie Star and posted in three places.

The minutes were read from the December 5th meeting, a motion was made by Fred Thistle to approve the minutes with correction (amount paid Columbia County was \$214.90 not 9,500.00), 2nd by John Benish, motion carried.

The Treasurer's report was as follows: General Account - \$44,638.49, and Taxes - \$309,638.49. A motion was made by Fred Thistle to approve the treasurer's report, 2nd by John Benish, motion carried.

A letter from Columbia County Zoning was read concerning all Wisconsin Power and Light land - stating that all buildings that have been build on W P & L land a long the Wisconsin River will be asked by W P & L. ~~to review construction lands.~~ to review construction Lands.

The bills were presented, a motion was made by Fred Thistle to pay the bills, 2nd by Dave Cole - motion carried.

A motion was made by Dave Cole to approve three Mobile Home Park Licenses (Pine Vista, Schoepp's, and Woodlake Trails), 2nd by Fred Thistle - motion carried.

The transfer site was discussed, the cost of having a 20 cubic yard dumpster put at the transfer site for building materials only would be \$150.00 per month, a addition \$150.00 for hauling fee and \$30 - \$50 per ton dumping fee. Also a user fee was discussed and also a per bag fee. It was decided to have Bill Casey from Columbia County, Mike Clark, Green Valley and Alan Treinen will have someone from the University of Wisconsin come to the February 6th meeting for discussion of different ways to handle our garbage.

Mr. Roland Unke came before the town board asking for permission to have a mobile home put on his property which will be used for farm use only. Since it was not on the agenda for our meeting - it will be tabled until the February meeting.
