

TOWN OF WEST POINT

The town board of the Town of West Point held the regular monthly meeting on Thursday, February 6, 1992 at 7:00 p.m. at the town hall. The town board members present were: John Benish-Chairman, Fred Thistle-1st Supervisor, Dave Cole-2nd Supervisor, Edith Eberle-Clerk, Joan Bader-Treasurer and Harry Sawyer-Assessor.

The meeting was published in the Lodi Enterprise and the Sauk Prairie Star and posted in three places.

The minutes were read from the January 9, 1992 meeting, a motion was made by Fred Thistle to approve the minutes with correction, 2nd by John Benish - motion carried.

The Treasurer's report was read, a motion was made by Fred to approve the report, 2nd by Dave Cole - motion carried.

The bills were presented, a motion was made by John Benish to hold Mayo Corporation until March, 2nd by Fred Thistle - motion carried. A motion was made by Fred Thistle to pay the other bills presented, 2nd by Dave Cole - motion carried.

A motion was made by Dave Cole to approve a variance to have a mobile home put on the <sup>Reuben</sup> ~~Roland~~ Unke property for farm use only, 2nd by Fred Thistle - motion carried.

Dogs were discussed as to who would pick up dogs etc. - after discussion the town clerk will contact the Town of Lodi to see how they handle there dogs - it will be tabled until March.

Bill Casey from Columbia County Recycling Center came to the meeting and gave the Town of West Point a good report on our recycling. Different suggestions were discussed on a user fee or a fee per bag - Bill Casey stated that it would be better to charge by the bag because people will be not put recyclable in with the garbage if they had to pay per bag - not a user fee. The Town of West Point needs to replace some signs at the recycling center. Also Columbia County Recycling Center has sheets on recycling that they would put our hours of operation and any thing else the town board would to have put on the sheets to be handed out at the recycling center at no cost to the Town. Our contract with Green Valley is up a the end of February - therefore the clerk will send our specifications to Green Valley and Waste Management for the bidding for a two year contract at the March meeting. A motion was made by Fred Thistle to table any decision on the recycling center until March meeting, 2nd by Dave Cole - motion carried

Chairman John Benish read the following responsibilities for the Town Planning Commission as follows: Master Plan for development in the Town, Oversee subdivisions (new proposals), Public utilities and placement of lines, Landfill and all property belonging to the Town of West Point, Land inventory and identification, Construction site erosion plan, mostly for subdivisions and new developments, Lake shore development, Public Parks and development, and Speed Limits. The town board added Public Utility, and Long Range Sewer.

There was a complaint of limbs hitting the school bus on Golf Road was received - after discussion Dave Cole is going to check on Golf Road and Pulvermacher Road and report back at the March meeting.

Weight limits on town roads was discussed, Chairman John Benish brought up Bonding of Town Roads vises Posting of Town Roads. After discussion - the Town of West Point will post all Town Roads for this Spring with a weight limit of 8,000 pounds. We will do more investigation and check with the attorney on having all town roads bonded at report back at the March meeting.

A motion was made by Fred Thistle to do a town audit of the Clerk's and Treasurer's Books on February 25, 1992 at the Clerk's home at 7:30 p.m., 2nd by Dave Cole - motion carried.

Town Engineer was table until the March meeting - at which time we will ask to have Mayo Corporation present.

A motion was made by Fred Thistle to go in close session in accordance with WI. Statue 19.85 (b), 2nd by Dave Cole - motion carried.

A motion was made by Fred Thistle to adjourn close session and return to open session, 2nd by Dave Cole, - motion carried.

Fred Thistle stated that he had complaints on personal property that was not on the tax roll. Fred has look at the tax roll and talked to the Town Assessor Harry Sawyer and that he was satisfied with the personal property on the tax roll.

A motion was made by Fred Thistle to adjourn the meeting, 2nd by John Benish - motion carried.
