

TOWN OF WEST POINT

The Town of West Point held the Annual Town Meeting on Tuesday, April 14, 1992 at 8:00 p.m. at the Town Hall. There were nine people present.

The meeting was published in the Sauk Prairie Star and the Lodi Enterprise and posted in three places.

The minutes from the November 19, 1991 were read and a motion was made by Harry Sawyer to approve the minutes as read, 2nd by Maurice Neumaier, Yes 9, No 0 - motion carried.

A motion was made by Dave Cole to donate \$200.00 to the Lodi Fair Association, 2nd by LeRoy Hoekman, Yes 9, No 0 - motion carried.

A motion was made by Maurice Neumaier to donate \$500.00 to the Garden Bluff Association, 2nd by Harry Sawyer, Yes 9, No 0 - motion carried.

A motion was made by Fred Thistle to donate \$150.00 to the Project Splash (a new swimming pool in Sauk City), 2nd by Maurice Neumaier, Yes 9, No 0 - motion carried.

It was discussed if the Town of West Point should have a fee for residents that are using the Recycling Center to help with the cost of handling and hauling of the Recycables. Also, discussed was charging a cost per bag instead of a fee, no action was taken.

It was discussed if the Town of West Point should hire a dog catcher full or part time. Since there was no money set a side in the town budget for a dog catcher - no action will be taken at this time.

The town roads were discussed, the town board will look at Pleasant View Road and O'Connor Road to see if there is a need to for culverts.

It was discussed about bonding companies - if they do damage to the Town Road that they are responsible to repair the roads. No action was taken.

There is a TRIP program for Columbia County available that Columbia County will receive \$40,000.00, which will be divided between the towns and cities that want to participate in - which the town or city has to match the same amount that they will receive.

Salaries for the town board members, clerk, treasurer and assessor was discussed. It was suggested that the Town Chairman and the Treasurer receive \$5,600.00, the Supervisors receive \$2,400.00, the Clerk and Assessor receive \$8,000.00. But no action was taken.

Street lighting on Gannon Road, Hwy 60 and the two public access. The Clerk is to check into the street light on Hwy 60 .

It was bought up the Sauk Prairie Ambulance Association would take all of the Town of West Point - with no cost to the people. After discussion - a motion was made by Maurice Neumaier to investiage the Town of West Point going as a whole town with the Sauk Prairie Ambulance Association or to tax only the Lodi Ambulance side of the Town of West Point for the Lodi Assessment, the same with the Sauk Prairie Ambulance side, 2nd by Dave Cole, motion carried. A public hearing will be held in the near future to discuss the Ambulance Service.

A motion was made by Fred Thistle to adjourn the meeting, 2nd by Dave Cole - Yes 8, No 0 - motion carried.
