

TOWN OF WEST POINT

The town board of the Town of West Point held there regular monthly meeting on Thursday, May 7, 1992 at 7:10 p.m. at the town hall. The town board members present were: Fred Thistle-1st Supervisor, and Dave Cole - 2nd Supervisor, Edith Eberle-Clerk, and Harry Sawyer-Assessor.

The meeting was published in the Lodi Enterprise and the Sauk Prairie Star and posted in three places.

The minutes were read from the April 9 meeting, a motion was made by Fred Thistle to approve the minutes, 2nd by Dave Cole, motion was carried.

The minutes were read from the April 21st meeting, a motion was made by Fred Thistle to approve the minutes with the following correction that the complaint for John Benish as town chairman was mute, 2nd by Dave Cole - motion carried.

The treasurer's report was \$81,864.07 - a motion was made by Dave Cole to approve the treasurer's report, 2nd by Fred Thistle - motion carried.

There was a letter from Jim Schantz asking to have open forum with Gene Miller - from the State of Wisconsin. The date of May 27, 1992 at 7:00 p.m. was set - the clerk will check with Gene Miller if the date is ok with him.

The bills were presented, there was a question on what to pay Brent Breunig - Dave Cole clarified the bill and it will be paid. A motion was made by Fred Thistle to pay the bills including the Breunig and Sauk Prairie Ambulance bill, 2nd by Fred Thistle - motion carried.

The town board set Saturday, May 16, 1992 to go and look at the town roads, the town board will meet at 10:00 a.m. at the town hall, the first stop will be at the Eugene Ballweg farm to look at the mobile home - to decide if it is permanent home or a mobile home.

John Benish reported that 911 will go into effect on September 5, 1992 and that all fire signs must be put out on the right hand side of the road (10 ft.) and 10 ft. from the driveway. There will be a notice of this put in the Lodi Enterprise and the Sauk Prairie Star.



Bud Styer had filed for a variance for Dee Statz to put on a 12x52 addition, which would look like a double wide when finished. A motion was made by Fred Thistle to grant the variance, 2nd by Dave Cole - yes - 2, no - 1.

The date of June 2, 1992 at 7:00 p.m. was set to meet with Sauk Prairie and Lodi Ambulance Boards to discuss either taxing Lodi Ambulance for the Lodi Ambulance District and the same with the Sauk Ambulance District or going with all one ambulance district.

It will cost about \$200.00 to have a pole put down on the corner of Golf Road and Hwy 60 for a street light. The State of Wisconsin has the final ok if the Town of West Point can put a street light on that corner.
