The town board of the Town of West Point held the regular monthly meeting on Thursday, June 4, 1992 at 7:13 p.m. at the Town Hall. The town board members present were: Fred Thistle-1st Supervisor, Dave Cole-2nd Supervisor, absent was John Benish-Chairman. Also present was: Edith Eberle-Clerk, and Harry Sawyer-Assessor.

The meeting was published in the Lodi Enterprise and the Sauk Prairie Star and posted in four places.

The minutes were read from the May 7 meeting, a motion was made by Fred Thistle to approve the minutes as read, 2nd by Dave Cole - motion carried.

John Benish-Chairman came at 7:19 p.m.

The minutes were read from the May 16th meeting, a motion was made by Fred Thistle to approve the minutes as amended, 2nd by John Benish - motion carried.

The minutes were read from the June 2nd meeting, a motion was made by Fred Thistle to approve the minutes, 2nd by ~~Fred Thistle~~ - motion carried.

The treasurers report was as follows: April 30, 1992 balance was \$82,130.46 which agrees with the bank balance, May bills were \$13,808.06, May receipts were \$20,989.30, Social Security - \$119.62 with a May balance of \$89,431.32 (not with bank balance), with June bills of \$13,772.98 - ending balance as of June 4 - is \$75,658.34. A motion was made by John Benish to approve the Treasurers report, 2nd by Fred Thistle - motion carried.

A letter was read from Tom Murphy concerning lake property of Harry Sawyer and how it is taxed. It will be put on the agenda for the July meeting.

Chairman John Benish is to talk to the Lodi Fire Chief and the Sauk Fire Chief on the division of districts.

The town board stated that the Septic System at Hickory Hills is being taken care of according to Alice Elser.

A motion was made by Fred Thistle to approve the bills that were presented, 2nd by Dave Cole - motion carried.

Darrell Klingenmeyer from Sunset Harbor Marina was present - the town board as Mr. Klingenmeyer questions about the premises on his Class B Beer License, after which a motion was made by Dave Cole to grant a Class B Beer License to Darrell Klingenmeyer, 2nd by Fred Thistle - motion carried.

A Cigarette License was presented for Darrell Klingenmeyer, a motion was made by Fred Thistle to grant the Cigarette License to Darrell Klingenmeyer, 2nd by Dave Cole - motion carried.

A Pop License was presented for Darrell Klingenmeyer, a motion was made by Dave Cole to grant the Pop License to Darrell Klingenmeyer, 2nd by Fred Thistle - motion carried.

The following Operator Licenses were presented: Mark William Bingham, Oliver G. Olson, and Mary Stone. A motion was made by Fred Thistle to grant the Operator Licenses, 2nd by John Benish - motion carried.

The matter of a Mobile Home on the Eugene Ballweg Farm - was to be turned over to Columbia County Zoning to look into the matter - also to reference the Letter of June 3, 1992 from Jeff Clark the attorney for the Town of West Point.

There were two applications for the Transfer Site Attendant - John Sweeney and Cleon Guethlein. After discussion a motion was made by Dave Cole to hire John Sweeney for the Transfer Site Attendant, 2nd by Fred Thistle - motion carried. A letter will be sent to Cleon Guethlein that is application will be kept on file and thanks for applying for the job.

Page 3 - June 4, 1992 - Town of West Point

A motion was made by Fred Thistle to have Scott Construction (upon receipt of a bid) due the following roads: Trails End, Smith Park, Blackhawk Road, Ferry View Circle, Davis Road -East of Hwy. 188 and East Harmon Road North of Hwy. 188, 2nd by Dave Cole - motion carried.

Dave Cole will check into what roads can be done with crack filling.

Mr. Tom Murphy was present representing the V.F.W. from Sauk City asking to have a fireworks permit for July 4th. They will have 3 individuals and an emergency vehicle on the premises during the fireworks. A motion was made by Fred Thistle to grant a fireworks permit to the VFW with proof of insurance, 2nd by Dave Cole - motion carried.

Ron Beaton from Anchor Property Management Corporation also asked the town board for a fireworks permit for July 4th for Woodlake Trails. After discussion a motion was to grant a fireworks permit to Woodlake Trails (with proof of insurance and a qualified person certification) by Fred Thistle, 2nd by Dave Cole - motion carried.

A letter from Baraboo Federal Bank - stating that they will be going from a mutual company to a stock company. No action was taken.

Columbia county has rated our town roads on the passer program.

A motion was made by Fred Thistle to have a sign put upon Gannon Road stating "NO UNLICENSED VEHICLES BEYOND THIS POINT" (right facing North), 2nd by John Benish - motion carried.

A motion was made by Dave Cole to allow the amended change Section 11.08, the Commercial District - to include CAR WASHES, 2nd by Fred Thistle - motion carried.

For the July meeting we will ask Kurt Dey to come to the Town Board Meeting in regards to Golf Road.

A motion was made by Dave Cole to adjourn the meeting, 2nd by Fred Thistle - motion carried.
