

TOWN OF WEST POINT

The town board of the Town of West Point held the regular monthly meeting on Thursday, September 3, 1992 at the Town Hall at 7:25 p.m. The town board members present were: Fred Thistle-Chairman, Alan Treinen-1st Supervisor, and A. Dave Cole-2nd Supervisor; also present were: Edith Eberle-Clerk, Joan Bader-Treasurer and Harry Sawyer-Assessor.

The meeting was published in the Lodi Enterprise and the Sauk Prairie Star and Posted in four places.

The first item on the agenda was Larry and Kim Wilkinson dogs. Kim Wilkinson stated that kids had been throwing cans at the dogs and the dogs had been barking at the kids, she also stated that she have kept all four dogs in the house since that incident. Kim stated that they will be moving in the next few months. The town stated that if there were any more complaints that a fine will be assessed. A motion was made by Fred Thistle table the management concerning Wilkinson dogs and to have Jerry Udelhoven talk with the Woodlake Trails Recreation board to see if there is anything they can do to help with dog control at Woodlake Trails, 2nd by Dave Cole - motion carried.

The minutes were read from the August 6, 1992 meeting. A motion was made by Alan Treinen to approve the minutes with correction, 2nd by Fred Thistle - motion carried.

The minutes were read from the August 25, 1992 meeting. A motion was made by Dave Cole to approve the minutes, 2nd by Alan Treinen, motion carried.

The Treasurers report was as follows: \$210,063.14 which agrees with the July Bank balance, end of August balance is \$99,728.20 and after paying the bills tonight the balance is \$56,131.60. A motion was made by Dave Cole to accept the Treasurers Report, 2nd by Alan Treinen - motion carried.

The bills were presented, a motion was made by Dave Cole to approve the bills, 2nd by Alan Treinen - motion carried.

The clerk was asked to check with Baraboo Federal to see if we could get a better rate of interest on our note.

East Harmon Road was put in west of the quarter line by Hickory Hill - therefore the drainage field and the septic for Hickory Hill is in the town right a way. A motion was made by Dave Cole to have the individual town board members look and the situation at Hickory Hills and report back at the October meeting, 2nd by Alan Treinen - motion carried.

It was stated that Oak trees should be trimmed in late fall or early spring to get rid of Oak Wilt.

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A motion was made by Dave Cole to accept the bid from Dave Wartner to remove the four large Elm Trees at Pleasant View Park boat landing at a cost of \$600.00, 2nd by Alan Treinen - motion carried. A letter will be sent to Dave Wartner and a thank you letter to Cy Dombeck for bidding on the four large Elm Trees.

A motion was made by Dave Cole to approve the report to be sent to Columbia County of Veterans graves at Garden Bluff Cemetery, 2nd by Alan Treinen - motion carried.

The Ordinance for Deposit Schedule and Citation Schedule was given to each town board member which they are to look at and bring back their recommendations at the October meeting. Each town board member will be give a book of all the Town Resolutions and Ordinances to look at. A motion was made by Dave Cole to table the Ordinance's, 2nd by Alan Treinen - motion carried.

Chairman Fred Thistle asked each of the town board members to think of division of responsibilities and a decision will be made at the October meeting.

Chuck Zeman stated the Lodi Fire Department has looked into the Hillestad property for purchasing - but the cost is \$75,000.00.

It was stated the there will be a special town board meeting on Thursday, September 10, at 7:30 p.m. at the Lodi City Hall with the Town of Lodi and the City of Lodi in connection with the Lodi Ambulance Association in connection with the new Ambulance Building.

There is a light at the beach area at Woodlake Trails that shines across the lake into Neal Schoepps house - he asked if the light could be shut off and turned that it faces the other direction. Fred Thistle is to check into this matter.

The John Evert fence problem, it was stated Mr. Carlson land is in Dane County - Dave Cole is to talk to the Town of Roxbury Chairman and Mr. John Evert to see if the situation of the cost of the fence repair can be shared equally between the two parties.

It was stated the Wisconsin Power & Light has flood rights since 1911 along the Wisconsin River. The people that own the land along the Wisconsin River their deeds say to the water edge. This is a problem between Wisconsin Power and Light and the people that own the land.

A motion was made to adjourn the meeting at 9:56 p.m. by Dave Cole, 2nd by Alan Treinen - motion carried.
