

SPECIAL MEETING

The Special Meeting of the Common Council of the City of Lodi was held on Thursday night, Sept. 10, 1992 at 7:30 P. M. in the council chambers of city hall. All members were present except Dolphin and Baebler, who were out of town.

Mayor Schultz called the meeting to order, stating that the first item on the agenda is a joint meeting with the Towns of Lodi, West Point, the Ambulance Commission, and E.M.T. Personnel, regarding the new ambulance building. The Ambulance Commission gave the Council and Boards a report of the study they have done for the past 3 years of various sites and buildings in the City, until they settled on the new site next to Hardees. Frank Groves stated that the original estimate they received for the new building and site preparation of approximately \$500,000.00 was too high. The Commission then presented preliminary plans for the new building to the Council and Boards, with a request for their input and approval before these plans are submitted to an architect. a discussion was held regarding the needs of the E.M.T. Personnel, and revising the plans submitted. A motion was made by Thistle, seconded by See, to approve a sum of \$300,000.00 for the building and site preparation, with the Commission having the option to come before the Council and Boards if the sum is insufficient to complete this project. Motion carried on a vote of 5 ayes, from the 2 townships, and 4 nays, from the city council.

A motion was made by Ness, seconded by Allan Johnson to approve a picnic beer license for St. Patricks annual fall festival, at 521 Fair Street, on September 27, 1992. Motion carried by unanimous vote.

As this concluded the purpose for which this meeting was called, a motion was made by Ness, seconded by Allan Johnson to adjourn. Motion carried by unanimous vote.

The next meeting of the Common Council of the City of Lodi will be held on Tuesday night, September 15, 1992 at 7:00 P. M. in the council chambers of city hall.
