

TOWN OF WEST POINT

A special town board meeting of the Town of West Point was held on Friday, October 23, 1992 at 4:30 p.m. at the John Evert farm. Those present were: Alan Treinen-1st Supervisor, Dave Cole-2nd Supervisor, Ervin Breunig-Chairman Town of Roxbury, Lloyd Carlson, John Evert and Edith Eberle-Town Clerk.

The meeting was published in the Sauk Prairie Star, and the Lodi Enterprise and posted in four places. Also registered letters were sent to Mr. Lloyd Carlson and Mr. John Evert (the wrong month was stated in the letters - but the town clerk called the two parties and informed them of the correct month).

On the agenda was the repair of the Evert/Carlson fence line. Dave Cole stated that the fence in question was approximately 705 - 710 feet in length, with a ditch of 40 ft. deep and 80 ft. width. Mr. John Evert stated he had called Mr. Carlson and asked him to fix his portion of the fence, but Mr. Carlson did not fix the fence and Mr. Evert wanted to put his cattle in for pasture, so Mr. Evert hired two people to help him and purchased a roll of barb wire fence and posts. The cost of materials was \$110.00 (10 posts at \$20.00, 10 posts at \$50.00 (new) and a roll of wire at \$40.00); the cost of labor was \$300.00. After discussion between the town boards, Mr. Carlson and Mr. Evert, a motion was made by Dave Cole to have Mr. Carlson pay Mr. Evert \$205.00 for half the cost of the repairs made to the fence (pay to the Town of Roxbury), 2nd by Alan Treinen - motion carried.

Also Mr. Lloyd Carlson agreed to fix the fence from now on.

Mr. Carlson and Mr. Evert are to work together and see what can be done with the ditch.

A motion was made by Alan Treinen to adjourn the meeting at 5:35 p.m., 2nd by Dave Cole - motion carried.
