The Special Town meeting was held at 7:45 p.m. The meeting was published and posted in four places in accordance with the Wisconsin Statutes No. 60.12 (1) (c).

The minutes were read from the April 14, 1992 town meeting, a motion was made to approve the minutes by Alan Treinen, 2nd by Tom Eberle - Yes-8, No-0 motion carried.

A motion was made by Tom Eberle to increase the salaries for the town employees as follows: Chairman - \$3,200.00 in 1993 and \$4,000.00 in 1994; Supervisors - \$1,600.00 in 1993 and \$2,000.00 in 1994, Clerk - \$5,000.00 in 1993 and \$6,000.00 in 1994, Treasurer - \$2,900.00 in 1993 and \$3,400.00 in 1994, and Assessor - \$5,000.00 in 1993 and \$6,000.00 in 1994, 2nd by Clifford Schweppe, Yes-8, No-0, motion carried.

A motion was made by Tom Eberle to approve the town tax levy of \$77,022.76 for 1993, 2nd by Edie Klamer - Yes - 8, No - 0, motion carried.

A motion was made by Harry Sawyer to approve the Highway Expenditures of \$54,000.00 in Maintenance and \$62,000.00 in Construction for 1993, 2nd by Edie Klamer - Yes-8, No-0, motion carried.

A fee was discussed for the Recycling Center - it was decided to put on the December agenda and there will be a public hearing on the fee for the Recycling Center in 1993.

It was stated that the Town of West Point will be looking for a dog catcher in 1993. If anyone is interested please contact one of the town board members. The position of dog catcher will be advertised at a later date.
