

TOWN OF WEST POINT

The town board of the Town of West Point held the regular monthly meeting on Thursday, December 3, 1992 at the Town Hall at 8:00 p.m. The town board members present were: Fred Thistle-Chairman, Alan Treinen-1st Supervisor, and A. Dave Cole-2nd Supervisor; also present were: Edith Eberle-Clerk, Joan Bader-Treasurer and Harry Sawyer-Assessor.

The meeting was published in the Lodi Enterprise and the Sauk Prairie Star and Posted in four places.

The minutes were read for the November 5, 1992 meeting. A motion was made by Alan Treinen to approve the minutes as read, 2nd by Dave Cole - motion carried.

The Treasurers report was \$77,967.82 in the general account(we have not received the bank statement). A motion was made by Dave Cole to accept the Treasurers Report, 2nd by Alan Treinen - motion carried.

Chairman Fred Thistle stated that outlet #2 in Woodland Hills has no access to the lot. Chairman Fred Thistle to check this out an report back at the January meeting. Also a question on the roads.

Alan Treinen gave a report of the Lodi School meeting held on Wednesday night - the school board and the administrator was asking the town officials on their opinion of the proposed school referendum. The next meeting will be December 9, 1992.

The bills were presented, a motion was made by Alan Treinen to pay the bills presented, 2nd by Dave Cole - motion carried.

A motion was made by Dave Cole to appoint the following people to the Election Committee, Gloria Zeman, Diane Kazmierczak, Mary Ellen Ballweg, Margaret Wittwer, Irene Riechman, Polly Olson, Kathy Ballweg, Rudy Oest, Bob Nelson, Esther Thistle, Yvonne Zeman, Margaret Benish, Gordon Parks, Molly Ryan, Jan Harris and Louise Benesh, 2nd by Alan Treinen - motion carried.

A letter was received from John Benish that he has to resign from the Ambulance Commission, Chairman Fred Thistle will appoint a new Ambulance Commission member in January.

A motion was made by Dave Cole to set January 26, 1993 at the Town Hall at 7:30 p.m. for the Town Caucus, 2nd by Alan Treinen - motion carried.

A motion was made by Dave Cole to put out on bid the Golf Course tree trimming in the West Point road right-a-way and Steckleberg Road (separate bids), 2nd by Fred Thistle - motion carried.

A letter was received from Sauk Recreational Program Committee asking to have West Point appoint a member to the committee, the clerk to write a letter to the committee stating that West Point is interested and that they will appoint someone at the January meeting.

A motion was made by Dave Cole to approve Miller Court as a town road, 2nd by Alan Treinen, motion carried.

A motion was made by Dave Cole to table Woodland Hills development roads until the January meeting, which Chairman Fred Thistle will check to see if a proper base was put under all of the roads in the development, 2nd by Alan Treinen - motion carried.

The fee for the Recycling Center was discussed - Alan Treinen stated that he had asked John Strussman from the U.W. how other town were handling the fees - he stated that per bag - each bag is a \$1.00. Also was discussed a per year fee. A motion was made by Dave Cole to table until January meeting and to have a statement put in with the taxes, 2nd by Alan Treinen - motion carried.

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A motion was made by Dave Cole to adjourn the meeting at 10:10 p.m., 2nd by Alan Treinen - motion carried.
