

TOWN OF WEST POINT

The Town of West Point held the Annual Town Meeting on Tuesday, April 13, 1993 at 8:00 p.m. at the Town Hall. There were 9 residents, and 1 land owner (not a resident) present.

The meeting was published in the Sauk Prairie Star and the Lodi Enterprise.

The annual town meeting was called to order by Fred Thistle - town chairman.

The minutes from the November 17, 1992 were read and a motion was made by Dave Cole to approve the minutes as read, 2nd by Edie Klamer, Yes 5, No 0 - motion carried.

The financial report was presented and question answered. A motion was made by Edie Klamer to approve the financial report, 2nd by Dave Cole, Yes 5, No 0 - motion carried.

A motion was made by Dave Cole to pay \$200.00 to the Lodi Fair Association, 2nd by Harry Sawyer, Yes 5, No 0 - motion carried.

A motion was made by Dave Cole to pay \$500.00 to Garden Bluff Association, 2nd by Harry Sawyer, Yes 6, No 0 - motion carried.

It was brought up about having the Town of West Point reassessed in 1994. It was explained that you have to be between 90 and 110% once every four years or the state will reassess the town at a cost to the town. The Town of West Point has been below 90% for two years. After a lot of discussion a motion was made by John Sweeney to have a reassessment done in 1994, 2nd by Edie Klamer, Yes 6, No 0, 3 abstained - motion carried.

It was brought up if the town would like to sell the town property. It would include park land in a subdivisions, town land at the recycling center, and town assess to the lake. It was the opinion of the people present to leave the town assess as they are. After more discussion a motion was made by John Sweeney to have the Planning Commission take inventory of all town lands and report back to the town board, 2nd by Dave Cole, Yes 9, No 0 - motion carried.

A motion was made by John Sweeney to match highway matching funds with Columbia County, 2nd by Harry Sawyer, Yes 9, No 0 - motion carried.

Bonding of the town roads was also discussed and a ditch and taking off a build up of sand on the shoulders in Aleray.

A motion was made by Harry Sawyer to adjourn the meeting, 2nd by John Sweeney, Yes 9, no 0 - motion carried.
