A motion was made by Alan Treinen to grant a fireworks permit for the VFW in Sauk City for July 3, 1993 we have a copy of insurance and they will sent us the copy of insurance, 2nd by Dave Cole - motion carried.

The motion was made by Fred Thistle to do the following roads: Selwood about one mile, and Gastrow Road (the middle section this year which will be .6 or .7 mile - the rest of the road to be done next year, 2nd by Dave Cole - motion carried. The work to be done by Columbia County Highway.
