On the agenda is: Rezoning for Agricultural to Single Family Residency for Dave and Nancy Schoepp.

The Planning Commission report for the rezoning was a tie vote 3 to 3.

After a lot of discussion and in view of the expected master plan of land use and as not to cause a precedent of rezoning active agricultural land, but the land next to the proposed site was zoned residential the town board vote was - Dave Cole - No, Fred Thistle - yes, the town board decided to go with the decision from a letter from board member Alan Treinen who was absent, the letter read was in favor of rezoning - therefore the rezoning for Dave and Nancy Schoepp was approved.

A motion was made by Dave Cole to adjourn the meeting at 8:35 p.m., 2nd by Fred Thistle - motion carried.
