

TOWN OF WEST POINT

Pursuant to Wisconsin State Statute 19.84, the town board of the Town of West Point held the regular monthly meeting on - Thursday, July 1, 1993 at the Town Hall at 7:30 p.m.. The town board members present were: Fred Thistle-Chairman, and A. Dave Cole-2nd Supervisor; Alan Treinen- 1st Supervisor was absent; also present were: Edith Eberle-Clerk, Joan Bader-Treasurer and Harry Sawyer-Assessor.

The meeting was published in the Lodi Enterprise and the Sauk Prairie Star and Posted in four places.

The minutes were read for the June 3rd meeting. A motion was made by Dave Cole to approve the minutes as read, 2nd by Fred Thistle - motion carried.

The minutes were read from the June 28th meeting. A motion was made by Dave Cole to approve the minutes as read, 2nd by Fred Thistle - motion carried.

2nd Supervisor Dave Cole stated that he felt it was a wrong decision on the rezoning of Dave and Nancy Schoepp from Agricultural to Residential.

The Treasurers report was \$59,350.99 in the general account. A motion was made by Dave Cole to accept the Treasurers Report, 2nd by Fred Thistle - motion carried.

A letter was read from the City of Portage stating that the Hazardous waste department was only for the City of Portage. The Columbia County board is checking to see if a contract can be worked out between the City of Portage and Columbia County. Chairman Fred Thistle will do some checking into this matter.

A letter was also received asking to have the haulers (Green Valley Disposal) that haul the Town of West Point garbage to Columbia County recycling center. We will check into this matter.

The bills were presented, a motion was made by Dave Cole to pay the bills presented, 2nd by Fred Thistle - motion carried.

Two Operator Licenses were present from Lake Wisconsin County Club, Edwin Frommung, and Todd Bauer, both have taken the bartenders course. A motion was made by Dave Cole to grant the licenses, 2nd by Fred Thistle - motion carried.

A copy of the insurance and liability was presented from Woodlake Trails (by Sherry Wagner) for fireworks. A motion was made by Dave Cole to allow fireworks on the 4th of July at Woodlake, 2nd by Fred Thistle-motion carried.

At the present time the only road to be done is Selwood Drive, after we will see how much money is left before doing more roads.

Page 2 - Town of West Point - July 1, 1993

A motion was made by Dave Cole to put out bids for an assessor for having a reassessment done in the Town of West Point, 2nd by Fred Thistle - motion carried.

Mr. Dan Heffron from Era Marquardt Agency, Mr. James Grothman from Grothman & Associates (land surveyors) and Mr. Art Zerley (owner of the land) asked the town board feelings on rezoning ^{24.3} ~~5.84~~ acres from commercial to made four residential lots. After discussion it was forwarded to the Planning Commission.

The question was brought up about having a user fee for construction material as it was very costly to the Town in May. It was tabled until the August meeting.

Two copies of letters were presented to the town board from General Engineering to the contractor (Gasser) that did Woodland Hills asking them to get the erosion control under control. Ron Steiner and the town engineer will be there to oversee the work so it is done right.

Chairman Fred Thistle brought up the DNR boat landings -

Okee boat landing has the problem of people parking on the road which is a safety hazard, also the road is not blacktopped. Chairman Fred Thistle talked to the DNR and as of July 1 they are to be received money to finish the road at Okee so signs can be put up stating no parking on the road. 2nd Supervisor asked if we could check with Mr. Benish to see if extra parking could be done on their farm.

East Harmon boat landing was also brought up as people are not following the 9:00 p.m. posted time to use the boat landing - people are coming in as late a 11:00 p.m. They call Columbia County Sheriff the response time is taking to long and by the time they get there the parties have gone. It was suggested that they get license numbers of car, boat, and trailer. We will be checking into this matter.

A motion was made by Dave Cole to adjourn the meeting at 8:52 p.m., 2nd by Fred Thistle - motion carried.
