The Town Board of the Town of West Point held a joint meeting with the Planning Commission, Town Lawyer, and Town Engineer on Thursday, August 26, 1993 at 8:00 p.m. The meeting was posted in four places.

Those present for the town board were - Fred Thistle-Chairman, Alan Treinen-1st Supervisor and Dave Cole-2nd Supervisor. Town Clerk - Edith Eberle was also present.

Those present for the planning Commission - Fred Madison, Alan Boehmer, Doug Richmond, Roger Ballweg, Joyce Sinkule, and John Sweeney. Sarah Boehmer was also present.

Mr. Jeff Clark and Mr. Joe Casinana were also present.

A sub division is 5 or more parcels and a minor sub division is 2 or more.

The planning commission is a review and recommending board.

Mr. Jeff Clark explained the procedure on handling a sub division etc., the clerk will be contacted by the person wishing to have a preliminary hearing on a sub division etc., the clerk with contact the Town Engineer and put the person on the agenda of the next planning commission meeting. Once the person has presented an application (certified Survey Map) and the fee - then the planning commission as 60 days to make a decision. After the planning commission has made a decision then the Town Board will make their decision. Rezoning is the last step in the process.

A public hearing is only on a sub-division.

Our sub-division ordinance regulates 4 acres or more.

On zoning issues-Columbia County still has the final say.

There was a lot of good information given to the planning commission and the town board from the town attorney and the town engineer.

A motion was made by Dave Cole to adjourn the meeting at 10:15 p.m., 2nd by Alan Treinen - motion carried.
