

TOWN OF WEST POINT

Pursuant to Wisconsin State Statute 19.84, the town board of the Town of West Point held the special meeting on Thursday, October 21, 1993 at the Clerk's home at 7:40 p.m.. The town board members present were: Fred Thistle-Chairman, Alan Treinen-1st Supervisor, and A. Dave Cole-2nd Supervisor; also present were: Edith Eberle-Clerk, and Harry Sawyer-Assessor.

The meeting was published in the Lodi Enterprise and the Sauk Prairie Star and Posted in four places.

Harry Sawyer - Assessor gave a report on Gardiner Appraisal - Harry felt he would do a good job (he was shown around the town by Harry). A motion was made by Dave Cole to hire Gardiner Appraisal for 24,700.00 to due a revaluation of the Town of West Point for 1994, 2nd by Alan Treinen - motion carried.

A resolution was read stating that the Town of West Point would borrow \$106,750.00 from the State Bank of Lodi to pay off the town's loan with Baraboo Federal Bank, Highway Construction of Selwood Drive, and Lodi Ambulance Building. A motion was made Dave Cole borrow the money from State Bank of Lodi, 2nd Alan Treinen - a roll call vote was taken as follows: Dave Cole - Yes, Alan Treinen - Yes, and Fred Thistle - Yes - motion was carried.

The rest of the evening the town board worked on the town budget. The town budget is increasing from \$77,022.76 in 1993 to \$195,099.13 in 1994 (this is due to a revaluation, increasing road budget, and no carry over).

A motion was made by Alan Treinen to adjourn the meeting at 10:30 p.m., 2nd by Dave Cole - motion carried.
