

TOWN OF WEST POINT

Pursuant to Wisconsin State Statute 19.84, the town board of the Town of West Point held the regular monthly meeting on - Thursday, November 4, 1993 at the Town Hall at 7:30 p.m.. The town board members present were: Fred Thistle-Chairman, Alan Treinen-1st Supervisor, and A. Dave Cole-2nd Supervisor; also present were: Edith Eberle-Clerk, Joan Bader-Treasurer and Harry Sawyer-Assessor.

The meeting was published in the Lodi Enterprise and the Sauk Prairie Star and Posted in four places.

Under Citizens Input - Mr. Greg Gardiner was introduced by Harry Sawyer, he will be doing a revaluation of the Town of West Point for the year 1994. Mr. Gardiner explained his procedure and he does have letter from the town of West Point to show the residents who they are, we will also put in the newspaper explained the reassessment.

Mr. Robbie Buchanan explained to the town board his plans of buying 48 acres and he has a certified survey map - he will go to the planning commission meeting on November 11, 1993.

There were residents from Woodlake Trails that have received letters stating that they owe money for the parking fee and annual maintenance - some of the residents have paid the parking fee - the clerk is to check into this and call some of the residents back at Woodlake Trails. The town has no copy of the change of receiver to Mr. Howard Koop - the clerk will talk to the town attorney.

The minutes were read from the October meeting. Alan Treinen made a stated that the property owner would not receive a bill until the third call was made to his property for a burglar alarm call. A motion was made by Alan Treinen to approve the minutes as read, 2nd by Dave Cole - motion carried.

The minutes were read from the special October meeting. A motion was made by Alan Treinen to approve the minutes as read, 2nd by Dave Cole - motion carried.

The Treasurers report was \$58,321.61 (which includes the \$21,217.25 for the ambulance building) in the general account. A motion was made by Alan Treinen to accept the Treasurers Report, 2nd by Dave Cole - motion carried.

A letter was read from Green Valley stating that beginning January 1, 1994 there will be an increase in the monthly amount from \$525.00 to \$577.00 - in the letter he will come to our meeting and explain more. This will be put on the December agenda.

The TRIP application for highway aids has been sent in by Chairman Fred Thistle.

Also a letter was received about the Sauk Prairie Municipalities forming a committee - they were asking for West Point to be represented. Dave Cole has gone to other meetings but as this meeting will fall on the Planning Commission meeting - Chairman Fred Thistle will go to the meeting.

The bills were presented, the question was brought up by Dave Cole of recovering some of the cost by the town engineer - the clerk will check into this with Joe Casinana. A motion was made by Dave Cole to pay the bills presented, 2nd by Alan Treinen - motion carried.

Under erosion control there were a couple of places that Fred Thistle will check out - one on Hwy V and one on Hwy. 113.

There was no more to report on the bridge repair.

A job description was presented for the transfer site attendant - it will be typed and copies made to be looked over and report back at the December meeting.

The town budget was discussed - and the town board is not changing the town budget as they feel everything that is in the budget is necessary.

A resolution (11/93) obligating the town to pay the county and state taxes was presented - a motion was made by Alan Treinen to adopt resolution 11/93, 2nd by Dave Cole - motion carried.

Mr. Arthur Zerler certified survey was presented - it has been approved by the town attorney, town engineer and planning commission. A motion was made by Dave cole to approve the certified survey for Mr. Zerler, 2nd by Alan Treinen - motion carried.

There is no close session until December.

A motion was made by Alan Treinen to adjourn the meeting at 9:40 p.m., 2nd by Dave Cole - motion carried.
