

TOWN OF WEST POINT

Pursuant to Wisconsin State Statute 19.84, the town board of the Town of West Point held the regular monthly meeting on - Thursday, January 6, 1994 at the Town Hall at 7:30 p.m.. The town board members present were: Fred Thistle-Chairman, Alan Treinen-1st Supervisor, and A. Dave Cole-2nd Supervisor; also present were: Edith Eberle-Clerk, and Harry Sawyer-Assessor. Joan Bader-Treasurer was absent.

The meeting was published in the Lodi Enterprise and the Sauk Prairie Star and Posted in four places.

The minutes were read for the December, 1993 meeting. A motion was made by Alan Treinen to approve the minutes as read, 2nd by Fred Thistle - motion carried.

There was no Treasurers.

The bills were presented, a motion was made by Alan Treinen to pay the bills presented, 2nd by Dave Cole - motion carried.

Dave Cole stated that there is a water problem in the first caldesuc in Fjords. Fred Thistle and Dave Cole are to check into the problem and report back at the February meeting.

Fred Thistle is to meet with the Town of Roxbury to discuss the fence problem and report back at a later meeting.

The fire inspections that the Lodi Fire Department made to public buildings and business were presented. There were three business that had some violations - Rasmussen and Associates, Woodlake Trails and Sunset Marina. Chairmperson Fred Thistle is to check into this matter with the Fire Department and report back at the February meeting. The board wants to know who enforces the violations etc.

The final draft of the Job Description for the Transfer Site Attendant was presented (the attorney has gone over and gave his recommendations which have been put into the Job Description). A motion was made by Alan Treinen to accept the Job Description for the Transfer Site Attendant, 2nd by Dave Cole - motion carried.

Woodlake Trails has been purchased by Bryee Corporation - but is not final until late January (in Dane County Court). Woodlake is also having dump problems-hopefully will be straighten out soon.

The town reassessment has all the new construction houses have been checked. Harry Sawyer asked the town board if pictures should be taken, he didn't feel that was necessary. The town board agreed not to have pictures taken.

The contract with Mead and Hunt for Gastrow Road has been signed. There will be a public hearing followed by a special town meeting on Gastrow Road explaining what will be done and the borrowing of the money for the construction on January 24, 1994 at 7:30 p.m.

John Sweeney stated he would like to resign from the Planning Commission at the end of his term which is April, 1994. Chairperson Fred Thistle thanked John for all he has done on the Planning Commission and he will find a replacement.

Woodlake Trails presented an application to the Town of West Point for a Mobile Home Park License. After discussion a motion was made by Alan Treinen to grant the license to Woodlake Trails (with Howard Koop receiver - until the court has finalized the sale Woodlake Trails), 2nd by Dave Cole - motion carried.

Schoepp's Cottonwood Resort presented an application to the Town of West Point for a Mobile Home Park License. After discussion a motion was made by Dave Cole to grant the license to Schoepp's Cottonwood Resort, 2nd by Alan Treinen - motion carried.

Pine Vista, Inc. presented an application to the Town of West Point for a Mobile Home Park License. After discussion a motion was made by Dave Cole to grant the license to Pine Vista, Inc., 2nd by Alan Treinen - motion carried.

An operator license for Thomas Cooler from Lake Wisconsin Country Club (Thomas has gone threw the Beverage Server Training), a motion was made by Alan Treinen to grant the operator license, 2nd by Dave Cole - motion carried.

John Reppen and other town residents had some question on why taxes went up and what the residents could do to help the Town Board hold down taxes. Roads are the biggest expense for the town- Chairperson explained in the Spring when the roads are posted if any resident see a over weighted truck on a town road - to please call a town board member or the Columbia County Sheriff. The Town Board will try to hold expenses down-but still try to get all town roads in better condition.

Robbie Buchanan could not make it to the January meeting. He would like to be on the February agenda.

There was no close session.

A motion was made by Alan Treinen to adjourn the meeting at 9:24 p.m., 2nd by Dave Cole - motion carried.
