

TOWN OF WEST POINT

The Town of West Point held the Annual Town Meeting on Tuesday, April 12, 1994 at 8:00 p.m. at the Town Hall. There was 14 people residents present and 1 quest (landowner).

The meeting was published in the Sauk Prairie Star and posted in four places in accordance with the Wisconsin Statutes No. 60.12 (1) (c).

The annual meeting was called to order by Fred Thistle - Town Chairman.

The minutes were read from the November 16, 1993 meeting. A motion was made by Bill Pratt to approve the minutes as read, 2nd by Harry Sawyer - Yes 10, No 1 - motion carried.

The minutes were read from the January 24, 1994 meeting. A motion was made by Dave Cole to approve the minutes as read, 2nd by Betty Pratt - Yes 12, No 1 - motion carried.

The financial report was presented and explained, questions were answered, after which a motion was made by Harry Sawyer to approve the financial report, 2nd by Jerry Udelhoven - Yes 12, No 1 - motion carried.

A motion was made by Steve Hoppe to give Garden Bluff Cemetery the usual \$500.00 plus an additional \$200.00 for gravel, 2nd by Bill Aylward - Yes 14, No 0 - motion carried.

A motion was made by Harry Sawyer to give the Lodi Fair Association \$200.00, 2nd by Jerry Udelhoven - Yes 13, No 1 - motion carried.

Abandoned wells were discussed, a fee of \$100.00 was discussed to help close the wells. After more discussion - there was no action taken at this time.

The Planning Commission has been working on the Land Use Plan and will be looking at all public property on how to handle them. There is 35.7 acres of public property (some are water ways) in the Town of West Point. The possibility of developing a program for planting wild flowers in parks.

Lake access were discussed. A motion was made by Bill Pratt to have the Town of West Point sell the water way on Trails End at a price to be negotiated, 2nd by Steve Hoppe - after discussion Mr. Pratt withdrew his motion.

Bill and Betty Pratt would like first change to buy the public access in Trails End if it goes up for sale.

It was pointed out that Spring is not the time to trim Oak Trees.
