

TOWN OF WEST POINT

Pursuant to Wisconsin State Statute 19.84, the town board of the Town of West Point held the regular monthly meeting on - Thursday, July 7, 1994 at the Town Hall at 7:30 p.m.. The town board members present were: Fred Thistle-Chairman, Alan Treinen-1st Supervisor, and A. Dave Cole-2nd Supervisor; also present were: Edith Eberle-Clerk, and Joan Bader-Treasurer. Harry Sawyer-Assessor was absent.

The meeting was published in the Lodi Enterprise and the Sauk Prairie Star and Posted in four places.

The minutes were read from the May 5, 1994 meeting. A motion was made by Dave Cole to approve the minutes as read, 2nd by Alan Treinen - motion carried.

The minutes were read from the June 6, 1994 meeting. A motion was made by Dave Cole to approve the minutes as read, 2nd by Alan Treinen - motion carried.

The Treasurers report was \$63,247.63 in the general account. A motion was made by Dave Cole to accept the Treasurers Report, 2nd by Alan Treinen - motion carried.

The bills were presented, a motion was made by Dave Cole to pay the bills presented, 2nd by Alan Treinen - motion carried.

Chairman Fred Thistle appointed Mr. Richard O'Connor to the Planning Commission for two years.

2nd Supervisor Dave Cole gave the following report from the Planning Commission - Rezoning for Roger Ballweg was approved (one acre of land only), Looking into the Erosion in Selwood, the application for Rezoning was approved (with minor changes), and at next meeting there will be public participation on land use (from local farmers).

On the reassessment - residential has been started - no date for Open Book.

There will be a meeting of Lake Front Property Owners, to form a Lake Association with the following towns: Lodi, West Point, Dekorra, and Merrimac - on August 8, 1994 at 7:30 p.m. at the Lodi High School.

The following operator applications were presented from Schoepps Cottonwood Resort - Pat Schoepp, Matt Passehl, Melvin M. Becker and Peter Schoepp. A motion was made by Alan Treinen to grant the operator licenses, 2nd by Dave Cole - motion carried.

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The following operator license application was presented from Crystal Lake Campground - Jessica F. Madison. A motion was made by Alan Treinen to grant the operator license, 2nd by Dave Cole - motion carried.

The following operator license application was presented from Lake WI. Country Club - Jennifer Kirch. A motion was made by Alan Treinen to grant the operator license, 2nd by Dave Cole - motion carried.

Agreement for Fencing and Pasture for the Recycling Center was discussed. 1st Supervisor Alan Treinen is to talk Jim Zeman and see what can be worked out. (some discussion was \$5.00 per head, he would maintain fence, and repair of ditch)

Roger Ballweg came before the town board wanting to rezone one acre of land. Planning Commission as approved. The amount of total acreage was discussed (9-12-15 acres). There would be three houses off one driveway - that brought up the question if there needs to be a certified survey and driveway brought up to town road standards. A motion was made by Fred Thistle to table this until the August meeting, 2nd by Dave Cole - motion carried.

Gastrow Road is to be started on July 5, 1994.

The question was brought up of swimming at town public boat landings on who is responsible. The Town Clerk is to check with the town's insurance company and report back at the August meeting.

There will be a meeting on Hwy. 60 reconstruction on July 12, 1994 from 6 - 8:30 p.m. with the presentation a 7:30 p.m.

A motion was made by Dave Cole to adjourn the meeting at 10:05 p.m., 2nd by Alan Treinen - motion carried.
