

## TOWN OF WEST POINT

Pursuant to Wisconsin State Statute 19.84, the town board of the Town of West Point held the regular monthly meeting on - Thursday, October 6, 1994 at the Town Hall at 7:30 p.m.. The town board members present were: Fred Thistle-Chairman, Alan Treinen-1st Supervisor, and A. Dave Cole-2nd Supervisor; also present were: Edith Eberle-Clerk, Harry Sawyer-Assessor. Joan Bader-Treasurer was absent.

The meeting was published in the Lodi Enterprise and the Sauk Prairie Star and Posted in four places.

The minutes were read from the September 1, 1994 meeting. A motion was made by Dave Cole to approve the minutes as read, 2nd by Alan Treinen - motion carried.

The minutes were read from the September 12, 1994 meeting. A motion was made by Dave Cole to approve the minutes as read, 2nd by Alan Treinen - motion carried.

The Clerk presented a computer printout that the Treasurer had prepared which said the balance in \$104,642.82 in the general account.

The following correspondence was presented: 1. There will be a meeting on November 7th for the new Lake District. 2. Letter from Lodi Fire Department on the signal not strong enough - sent to the 911 committee. 3. Letter not in favor of development (on Jensen property). 4. Letter from Wisconsin Department of Transportation on Translinks 21 which is a preliminary 25 year transportation plan.

The bills were presented, a motion was made by Dave Cole to pay the bills presented, 2nd by Alan Treinen - motion carried.

The Planning Commission Report was as follows: Joyce Sinkule to write plan, extra territory(annexed), Taylor property rezone was voted not in favor of rezoning, Letter-property in question on Hwy 60 was also discussed.

A motion was made by Dave Cole to have Open Book on October 24 & October 25, 1994 from 9:00 a.m. to Noon, 1:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. and Board of Review is on October 28, 1994 from 10:00 a.m. to adjournment, 2nd by Alan Treinen - motion carried.

Barbara Sandor a resident from Slack Hill presented a petition with 4 requests as follows: 1. Lower the speed limit to 25 mph on Slack Road and Hillcrest Drive; 2. Add a Dead End sign at the entrance to Slack Road; 3. Add a Y-type Intersection sign at the intersection of Slack Road and Hillcrest Drive; 4. Add a centerline stripe to entire lengths of Slack Road and Hillcrest Drive. After a lot of discussion with other residents from the area - a motion was made by Dave Cole to adopt the four requests and to forward these to Columbia County Highway for their approval, 2nd by Alan Treinen - motion carried.

A letter was received from Columbia County Economic Development asking the Town of West Point to join at a cost of \$1,928.36 (a cost \$1.42 per person population). It was decided to forward this request to the Planning Commission for their input.

Land Use Plan - Joyce Sinkule is working on the plan a long with Fred Madison and be presented at the October 13, 1994 meeting.

Chairman Fred Thistle went over Gastrow Road with the Town Engineer on October 5, the soft spots have been taken care and they will be paving next week.

Brian Rosolonski, Edwin Rosolonski and Keith Rumisek were introduced and the replacements for John Sweeney if he can not work at a schedule time at the recycling center. The clerk is to send copies of the Recycling Ordinance and Job Description to each of the three employees.

The Agreement for Fencing and Pasture at the Recycling Center was presented. After discussion a motion was made by Alan Treinen to sign the agreement and be taken to Jim Zeman to sign, 2nd by Dave Cole - motion carried.

Copies of different ordinance were presented (including have the town adopt building permits), these copies will be forwarded to the planning commission for their input and brought back to the November town board meeting.

The clerk is to talk to the Town Attorney Jeff Clark on the Legal fee - for the building permit ordinance and fee schedule and have the cost for the Budget meeting on October 20, 1994.

A motion was made by Dave Cole to have 5 people work at the November election, polls open at 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m., and to get noon meal for election workers, 2nd by Alan Treinen - motion carried.

A motion was made by Dave Cole to have October 20, 1994 was to work on the 1995 budget at the Clerk's home, 2nd by Alan Treinen - motion carried.

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A motion was made by Alan Treinen to put the following roads out on bid\* Barta Road from Hwy 60 to Schoepp Road, Reynolds Road from Hwy. 60 to Lovering Road, and Chrislaw Road from Hwy. J to the Town Line (fence line to fence line), work to be completed by March 15, 1995, proof of liability insurance, brush disposed of and cut at ground level etc., 2nd Dave Cole - motion carried.

A motion was made by Alan Treinen to adjourn the meeting at 9:15 p.m., 2nd by Dave Cole - motion carried.
