

TOWN OF WEST POINT

Pursuant to Wisconsin State Statute 19.84, the town board of the Town of West Point held the regular monthly meeting on March 2, 1995 at the Town Hall at 7:30 p.m.. The town board members present were: Fred Thistle-Chairman, Alan Treinen-1st Supervisor, and A. Dave Cole-2nd Supervisor; also present were: Edith Eberle-Clerk, Joan Bader-Treasurer and Harry Sawyer-Assessor.

The meeting was published in the Lodi Enterprise and the Sauk Prairie Star and Posted in three places.

Under Citizens Input - Asked about sweeping of roads, meeting in Madison on March 6 at 10:00 am to write a survey on the Ferry, Harry Sawyer stated that WI. Power and Light is in the tax roll, Trisha Kirner has been working on this case with WI. Power and Light - Dave Cole is to ask her to come to our April meeting.

The minutes were read from the February 2, 1995 meeting. A motion was made by Alan Treinen to approve the minutes as read, 2nd by Dave Cole - motion carried.

The Treasurers report was ~~\$~~159,636.91 after the bills are paid tonight in the general account. A motion was made by Alan Treinen to accept the Treasurers Report, 2nd by Dave Cole - motion carried.

The bills were presented, a motion was made by Alan Treinen to pay the bills presented, 2nd by Dave Cole - motion carried.

Chairman Fred Thistle stated that the Hegge have moved their dog pen behind the house. Hopefully that will take care of the dog problem. The Davis property now has 40 acre lots not 35 acres so they are now dealing with Columbia County not the Town.

Weight Limits will go into effect on March 13, 1995. If anyone has any questions call the Chairman.

The planning commission report as follows - Edgar Walsh & Tim Bender came before the planning commission and presented more plans, the Land Use Plan is coming along well (will include maps), on Pustaver land the commission felt that the town should receive money for the park land.

The ordinances (driveway, uniform dwelling and building permits) are tabled until April. A motion was made by Dave Cole to have a public hearing on the ordinances on April 11, 1995 at 7:00 p.m., then Annual Meeting, then special town meeting immediately following, 2nd by Alan Treinen - motion carried. Will try to get the ordinances to the Planning Commission in March.

A bid for \$975.00 for brushing of West Harmon Road was received from Brush Cutting - a motion was made by Dave Cole to have Brush Cutting Service do West Harmon Road, 2nd by Alan Treinen - motion carried. Chairman Fred Thistle to contact Brush Cutters.

Sauk Fire Department presented the town board with fire inspection reports (no inspection for the Bed and Breakfast) as the State do the Bed and Breakfast. Chairman Fred Thistle thank the fire department for coming to the town board and if they would let them know if there is any violations. Also, to do more checking into a water supply for fires from Lake Wisconsin or Crystal Lake.

There was two people present from Sauk School and explained the referendum on the April ballot for the additions to the schools.

No one was present for the fireworks - so a motion was made by Dave Cole to table the fireworks until April, 2nd by Alan Treinen - motion carried.

Chairman Fred Thistle looked over the Clerk's books and has passed them on to another board member.

Joe Costanza was present - there was discussion on building permits being issued, decks, siding, furnace and air conditioners, if there should be a fee or not. No decision. Be on April agenda. Also the town attorney should define alteration.

Joe Costanza also has been meeting with Mr. Bender, town chairman Fred Thistle ask to have Mr. Costanza to remind Mr. Bender that he is responsible for any bills from Mr. Costanza.

Mr. Jeff Elser has asked for a variance on Hwy 188 for a set back of 95 ft. to build a second story house above a garage. A motion was made by Dave Cole to grant the variance, 2nd by Alan Treinen - motion carried.

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There will be a special meeting with the Town of Lodi, City of Lodi, and the Town of West Point on March 14, 1995 at 8:00 p.m. at the City Hall in Lodi. On the agenda is the Ambulance Commission members.

A motion was made by Dave Cole to adjourn the meeting at 9:51p.m., 2nd by ~~Dave Cole~~ - motion carried.
