

TOWN OF WEST POINT

Pursuant to Wisconsin State Statute 19.84, the town board of the Town of West Point held the regular monthly meeting on April 6, 1995 at the Town Hall at 7:30 p.m.. The town board members present were: Fred Thistle-Chairman, and A. Dave Cole-2nd Supervisor; also present were: Edith Eberle-Clerk, Joan Bader-Treasurer and Harry Sawyer-Assessor. Absent - Alan Treinen-1st Supervisor.

The meeting was published in the Lodi Enterprise and the Sauk Prairie Star and Posted in four places.

Under Citizens Input - Ken Harris present the town board with a letter asking to have a street light put up at Pine Vista and Golf Road and a center line put on Golf Road from Hwy 60 to Golf Course. Copies of this letter will be made for town board members, Town Engineer and put on the May agenda. There is a survey on the ferry given to all people who ride the ferry.

The minutes were read for the March 2, 1995 meeting. A motion was made by Dave Cole to approve the minutes as read, 2nd by Fred Thistle - motion carried.

The Treasurers report was \$175,219.40 after the bills paid tonight. A motion was made by Dave Cole to accept the Treasurers Report, 2nd by Fred Thistle - motion carried.

A copy was given to the board members of the bills, a motion was made by Dave Cole to pay the bills presented, 2nd by Fred Thistle - motion carried.

Chairperson Fred Thistle stated that the dog problem on Pustaver Road has been resolved.

2nd Supervisor Dave Cole submitted a copy of the Land Use Plan from the Planning Commission.

There was a letter from Columbia County Zoning that the Mr. Russell Morter was granted a rezoning from agricultural to Single Family Residence on Hwy. 113.

The following Ordinances (Control Private Access to Town Roads (Driveway), Uniform Dwelling Code and Creation of the Position of Building Inspector) were reviewed with Attorney Jeff Clark and Town Engineer Joe Costanza - a few minor changes were made. A final draft will be presented at the Public Hearing on April 11, 1995. There will also be a special town board meeting held on April 11, 1995 for final approval of the Ordinances.

A ~~Respective~~ ^{Representative} for Tim Beerkircher came before the town board with a letter stating that the Sauk Prairie Police Department and the Fire Chief have no objections to the Fireworks show on July 15 for the Harley Davidson Muscular Dystrophy Ride. Therefore, a motion was made by Fred Thistle to grant the fireworks display on July 15, 2nd by Dave Cole - motion carried. A copy of proof of insurance was also given the board.

Joan Bader stated that the following places still owe personal property taxes, Brylee Corporation, Tri-J, Inc., Dan Schoepp, and Odan (radio tower) for 2 years. After discussion the Town Clerk is to some checking into Odan radio tower and have them come to the next town board meeting.

A motion was made by Fred Thistle to approve that the town board had Audited of the town books, 2nd by Dave Cole - motion carried.

Vicki Lane from the State Bank of Lodi presented the Town Board with a check of \$150.00 for the park fund. This money comes from Mastercard or Vista cards that each time people use their cards \$.10 is put in the park fund. Chairperson Fred Thistle thanked the State Bank of Lodi - stating that last year their donation was the first in a park fund and since then we have made another donation to the park fund - a total of \$3,000.00.

Chairperson Fred Thistle gave the following report on the Wisconsin Town Association Meeting - No Cost Controls, AB106 a bill in that State legislature how to assess land that is zoned residential but is cropped, Gas Tax, All Counties to do Assessments of land, Clerk to a appointed position for 3 years, to put the Town Insurance out on Bid.

Chairperson Fred Thistle stated that he will go look at all town roads and bring a report back to the town board at the May meeting on which roads should be done this year.

The Resolution for the Ice Age Trail was tabled until May.

Mrs. Kirner and WI. Power and Light was tabled until the May meeting.



The discussion of Pustaver certified survey to was as follows to deny the proposed four-lot certified survey map located west of Pustaver Road and North of County V to ensure that the map was not automatically accepted under the provision of the Town's land division and subdivision regulations. Also a fee of \$300.00 should have been sent to the Town Treasurer. A motion was made by Fred Thistle to deny the proposed four lot certified survey to ensure that the map was not automatically accepted, 2nd by Dave Cole - motion carried.

A motion was made by Fred Thistle to adjourn the meeting at 10:35p.m., 2nd by Dave Cole - motion carried.
