The Ordinance to Adopt the Uniform Dwelling Code and the Creation of the Position of Building Inspector #4-11-95A was presented. A motion was made by Dave Cole to adopt the Ordinance, 2nd by Alan Treinen, motion carried.

The Ordinance to Control Private Access to Town Roads #4-11-95B was presented. A motion was made by Alan Treinen to adopt the Ordinance, 2nd by Dave Cole, motion carried.

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The Resolution in Connection with Ordinance #4-11-95A was presented. A motion was made by Dave Cole to adopt the Resolution, 2nd by Alan Treinen - motion carried.

The Ordinance Permitting Issuance of Citations for Violation of Ordinances and Providing a Schedule of Cash Deposits was presented. A motion was made by Dave Cole to table this Ordinance until the May meeting-so the board can have time to look to see if anything had been missed, 2nd by Alan Treinen, motion carried.

The contract from Municipal Engineering & Inspection Services, Inc. was presented and explained (the Town of West Point will receive 4% of each building permit issued and in six months the time the Clerk and Treasurer will have spent for Administration fees will be reviewed). A motion was made by Dave Cole to accept the contract (we will be receiving a final copy), 2nd by Alan Treinen, motion carried.
