

TOWN OF WEST POINT
JOINT MEETING WITH TOWN OF LODI, AND CITY OF LODI

The town board of the Town of West Point held a joint meeting at City Hall in Lodi, WI. on Wednesday, October 18, 1995 at 7:01 p.m. on the agenda is the Lodi Fire and Ambulance Budgets.

The meeting was posted in four places.

Added to the agenda is Rescue Fee, Gibraltar Park and Swim Pool.

1. The Lodi Area Fire Commission presented 1996 Budget of \$106,800 vs. \$105,800 for 1995. West Point '0" increase. Budget approved unanimously.

2. Ambulance Budget for 1996 is \$118,230 vs. \$116,700 for 1995. West Point share is \$18,246.00. Director doing very well - membership continues to be a problem. Budget approved unanimously. Act 102 funds adjustment for Ambulance and Fire Runs Total annually at time of budget.

3. Rescue fee billed with fire. Fire Bills: \$225.00 for fire run and \$125.00 for rescue run.

Fire and Ambulance will coordinate billing.

4. Gibraltar Rescue - Columbia County highway committee is in charge of all county parks. Not ADA assessable. County wants to get rid of the PARK - probably return to original owner/heirs. County ordinance for park/fines for climbing.

5. Swim Pool Fees - Municipalities donate (West Point \$500) plus user fees. Legal agreement is question. Each municipality check with legal council regarding donations from one municipality to another.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:42 p.m.
