

TOWN OF WEST POINT

Pursuant to Wisconsin State Statute 19.84, the town board of the Town of West Point held the regular monthly meeting on December 7, 1995 at the Town Hall at 7:30 p.m. The Town Board members present were: Fred Thistle-Chairperson, Alan Treinen-1st Supervisor, and A. Dave Cole-2nd Supervisor. Also present was Edith Eberle-Town Clerk, Joan Bader - Treasurer and Harry Sawyer - Assessor.

The meeting was published in the Lodi Enterprise and the Sauk Prairie Star and posted in four places.

The minutes from the November 2, 1995 meeting had been given to the town board members prior to the meeting. A motion was made by Dave Cole to approve the minutes with one correction, 2nd by Alan Treinen - motion carried.

The Treasurer's report was given by the town clerk as follows: General fund is \$139,072.56 and the Park Fund is approximately \$27,000.00. A motion was made by Dave Cole n to approve the Treasurers Report as given, 2nd by Alan Treinen - motion carried.

A letter was received from Sauk Prairie School that there will be a special election in February.

A copy of the bills was given to each of the town board members for review. A motion was made by Alan Treinen to pay the bills presented and also to pay the Columbia County Highway Bill in December, 2nd by Dave Cole - motion carried.

Under citizens input was the following: Town have own snow removal equipment (check with Roxbury on Budget etc., stop sign on Schoepp Road, Trees on Golf Road (Golf Course), and WI. Power & Light Land.

Planning Commission Report- new gravel pit on Hwy. 60, what is Park fund money used for, Rosa - three parcel.,

Road Construction/ Brushing for O'Connor Road and Schoepp Road to be put on January agenda.
