

## TOWN OF WEST POINT

Pursuant to Wisconsin State Statute 19.84, the town board of the Town of West Point held a special meeting at 9:15 p.m. at the West Point Town Hall on April 22, 1996. The Town Board Members present were: Fred Thistle-Chairperson, Alan Treinen-1st Supervisor, and Dave Cole-2nd Supervisor. Also present was Edith Eberle - Town Clerk and Joe Costanza - Town Engineer.

The meeting was posted in four places.

A West Point History was presented to the town board for their input, to be used in the Land Use Plan. Pat Schuknecht, Edie Eberle and Dave Cole have been working on the history. After discussion on whether it is too lengthy it was decided to send the history to John Stockham at the Discovery Group and he can use and edit the history to what ever he feels appropriate. The town board would like the final copy back before the May 9th meeting with the planning commission to review the Land Use Plan.

Tom and Paula Larrabee came before the town board asking for a variance to rebuild their home which was destroyed by fire earlier this year. If their house was on a lot line it would only be required to be 10 ft away from the lot line, but it is a right of way which requires 30 ft. Therefore a variance is required to rebuild their home. The planning commission has approved the variance. A motion was made by Dave Cole to approve the variance for Tom and Paula Larrabee, 2nd by Alan Treinen - motion carried.

The procedure to vacate the road known as Hillside Way in the Pleasant View Park Plat, requires a 3 weeks notice in the Lodi Enterprise and the Sauk Prairie Star. Mr. & Mrs. Larrabee and Mr. & Mrs. Halvik (owners on the other side of the road) have agreed to pay all attorney, engineer, and publication fees to have the road vacated. It is being published on April 25, May 2 and May 9, 1996. There will be a special meeting held on May 9, 1996 at 7:30 p.m. at the West Point Town Hall to vacate Hillside Way.

Chairperson Fred Thistle took a poll to give the Larrabee's the feelings of the town board on vacating the road, the board is in favor of vacating the road.

A motion was made by Dave Cole to adjourn the meeting  
at 9:45 p.m., 2nd by Alan Treinen - motion carried.
