Pursuant to Section 66.296(1) of the Wisconsin Statutes the town board of the Town of West Point held a special town board meeting on May 9, 1996 at 7:30 p.m., at the Town of West Point Town Hall. The meeting was published in the Lodi Enterprise and the Sauk Prairie Star for three weeks and posted in four places.

The following member were present: Fred Thistle - Town Chairman, and Dave Cole - 2nd Supervisor. Also present: Edith Eberle - Town Clerk and Jeff Clark - Town Attorney. Alan Treinen was absent.

On the agenda is Discontinuance of Hillside Way located in Pleasant View Park.

The lands affected are Lots 56 and 57, in the Plat of Pleasant View Park. Owners affected by the discontinuance are Tom and Paula Larrabee and Don and Debbie Halvik.

There were no people present who were opposed to the discontinuance of Hillside Way.

Chairman Fred Thistle read the order to discontinue Hillside Way, the land will be divided equally to both land owners. The landowners will have to have the land surveyed if they want an exact bounty line. A motion was made by Dave Cole to discontinue Hillside Way in Pleasant View Park and to be divided equally between the Larrabee's and the Halvik's, 2nd by Fred Thistle - motion carried.
