

## TOWN OF WEST POINT

Pursuant to Wisconsin State Statute 19.84, the town board of the Town of West Point held the regular monthly meeting on January 7, 1999 at the Town Hall at 7:30 p.m. The Town Board members present were: Fred Thistle-Chairperson, Alan Treinen - 1st Supervisor and A. Dave Cole-2nd Supervisor. Also present was Edith Eberle-Town Clerk, and Joan Bader - Treasurer.

The meeting was published in the Lodi Enterprise and the Sauk Prairie Star and posted in three places.

The minutes from the December 3rd, 1998 meeting had been given to the town board members prior to the meeting. The motion was made by Alan Treinen to approve the minutes, 2nd by Dave Cole - motion carried.

The Treasurer's report was given by the town clerk as follows: General fund is \$1,053,554.54 after bills tonight, and the Park Fund is \$68,805.72. A motion was made by Alan Treinen to approve the Treasurers Report as given, 2nd by Dave Cole - motion carried. The Town Treasurer also stated that the Town Clerk and Town Treasurer books agreed with the bank statement for December, 1998.

The following correspondence was: bridge inspection report on Old Sauk Road.

A copy of the bills was given to each of the town board members for review. A motion was made by Alan Treinen to pay the bills, 2nd by Dave Cole - motion carried.

The Planning Commission Report - was a parking lot (Golf Road) meeting scheduled in February will be held at the Town Hall.

Keith Rumisek, recycling center superintendent gave the following report - Keith had talked to Dekorra township on using a compactor at their recycling center. We could lease a compactor for a 3 month trial bases, we would need a concrete slab with 220 electric power, the cost would be about 7.18 per month. All the recycling material will go to Columbia County. Keith also asked to have a construction dumpster 3 times a year possibly July. Madison tire will take tires for recycling. The town board asked to have Green Valley Disposal come to the February meeting. Keith also asked to have cards for each resident of West Point.

RECYCLING CENTER CONTINUED

A motion was made by Dave Cole to have the town attorney review the ordinance and make changes that residents be required to have a card to go to the recycling center, 2nd by Alan Treinen - motion carried.

Columbia County Sheriff Steve Rowe and Detective Mike Babcock came before the town board on the question on fire arms. Chairman Fred Thistle had stated that there were shots in alleray sub division. The town board is considering a proposed town ordinance to control fire arms. Teenager's cannot have hand guns. Fred Thistle is not comfortable in answering these calls. The mechanisms in place with Columbia County. Sheriff Rowe had copies of the reviewed ordinances and handed out copies. Columbia county does not have a ordinance to restrict fire arms. Sheriff Rowe advised local officials to call police force if they have any complaints on discharging fire arms. A motion was made by Dave Cole to drop the Fire Arms Ordinance, 2nd by Alan Treinen - motion carried.

Liquor license ordinance was presented to the town board for discussion. Discussion included fees that will be charged (\$10,000.00). A motion was made by Fred Thistle to table the ordinance for one month, 2nd by Alan Treinen - motion carried. There will be a public hearing on the ordinance, and on the new reserve license

Christopher Coupland came before the town board asked permission to have a water ski tournament on August 27, 28, and 29, 1999 on Crystal Lake. A motion was made by Dave Cole to approve the water ski tournament, 2nd by Alan Treinen - motion carried.

Copies of Columbia county zoning ordinance - title 16 - chapter 1 have been given to the town board members for review. The ordinance has two separate areas: 1. Accsssory Buildings and 2. Storage of Junk, Trash and Inoperable Vehicles. A motion was made by Dave Cole that they are in favor of the changes, 2nd by Alan Treinen - motion carried

A motion was made by Dave Cole to amend Ordinance #10-3-96 election hours, change the hours to 7 a.m. to 8 p.m. for all elections, 2nd by Alan Treinen - motion carried. The new election hours will take effect for the April, 1999 election. The clerk to call the town attorney to have him update the ordinance and present at the February meeting for final approval.

A proposal from Kysinski & Associates, S.C. for \$2,300.00 to audit the books for the Town of West Point including the preparation of the Department of Revenue form C report. A motion was made by Dave Cole to hire Kysinski & Associates, S.C. to audit the Town of West Point books for 1998 and to do the Form C report, 2nd by Alan Treinen - motion carried.

A operator license for Laurie Rinehart was presented from Lake Wisconsin Country Club, she has attended the bartenders class. A motion was made by Alan Treinen to grant Laurie Rinehart a Operator License, 2nd by Dave Cole - motion carried.

Schoepp's Cottonwood Resort presented an application for a mobile home park license for 46 mobile homes for the town board approval. A motion was made by Alan Treinen to grant the mobile home park license for Schoepp's Cottonwood Resort, 2nd by Dave Cole - motion carried.

Pine Vista Mobile Home Park presented an application for a mobile home park license for 67 mobile homes for the town board approval. A motion was made by Alan Treinen to grant the mobile home park license for Pine Vista Mobile Home Park, 2nd by Dave Cole - motion carried.

Crystal Lake Campground presented an application for a mobile home park license for 169 mobile homes for the town board approval. A motion was made by Alan Treinen to grant the mobile home park license for Crystal Lake Campground, 2nd by Dave Cole - motion carried.
