

TOWN OF WEST POINT

Pursuant to Wisconsin State Statute 19.84, the Town Board of the Town of West Point held their regular monthly meeting on Thursday, January 6, 2000 at 7:30 p.m. at the West Point town hall. The meeting was published in the Lodi Enterprise and the Sauk Prairie Star and posted in three places.

The Town Board members present were: Fred Thistle-Chairperson, Alan Treinen-1st Supervisor, and Robert Davis-2nd Supervisor. Also present was Edith Eberle-Town Clerk and Joan Bader-Town Treasurer.

The minutes from the December 2nd, 1999 meeting had been given to the town board members prior to the meeting. A motion was made by Alan Treinen to approve the minutes, 2nd by Robert Davis – motion carried.

The town treasurer gave the Treasurer's report as follows: General fund was \$969,742.36 at the end of December, of which \$7624.30 was the amount in the general fund before taxes. Park Fund was \$73743.71. A motion was made by Robert Davis to accept the treasurer's report as given, 2nd by Alan Treinen – motion carried.

Correspondence – Ice Age Trail, Census grant that Columbia County has applied for, a Census form to be filled out by town chairperson and clerk after meeting. Letter from Department of Natural Resources on a Riprap permit for Mr. Bill Bletsch, Woodland Tax Law Contracts that expired on December 31, 1999 was Paul Benesh, David Beyer, and Geri Edwards. A final revised copy of the proposed amendments relating to storage of junk, trash and inoperable motor vehicles for Columbia County.

A copy of the bills was given to each of the town board members for review. A motion was made by Alan Treinen to pay the bills, 2nd by Robert Davis – motion carried.

Public Input – It was reported that James and Son has been given the Highway 60 project; the board has heard of complaints from Jensen Bus Service on the snow plowing in the Town of West Point; some money was donated to the Fish Lake project.

Town of West Point – January 6th, 2000

The Town of West Point has not found anyone that is interested in the Recycling Center Supervisor position, therefore on January 8th – Robert Davis will work at the recycling center with Keith Rumisek, January 15th – Fred Thistle will work at the recycling center, and January 22nd Alan Treinen will work at the recycling center. We will keep looking for someone to take the recycling supervisor position, but until we find someone each member of town board will take turns working at the recycling center.

A motion was made by Robert Davis to table until the February meeting the Emergency Operation Plan, 2nd by Alan Treinen – motion carried.

Town chairperson, Fred Thistle reminded everyone present on how important it is to fill out the census forms when they are received in the spring.

The Columbia County Wisconsin Towns meeting, which will be held on January 31st, 2000 at 7 p.m. there will be a 3-hour board of review training. Each town board member is encouraged to attend this meeting.

Discussion on who would be the Dog lister for the town of West Point, there is no one is interested in being the dog lister. A motion was made by Alan Treinen to table the dog lister and we will talk to Columbia County, 2nd by Robert Davis – motion carried.

Discussion on having a deputy Clerk for the Town of West Point was brought up. The deputy clerk could take over the Planning Commission minutes and posting of the agenda and any other duties that the town clerk need help with. A motion was made by Fred Thistle to have Sharon Richmond appointed as deputy clerk, 2nd by Robert Davis – motion carried.

The town clerk presented the town board with a picture and price of new chairs for the town officers from Ryne Supply from Portage. After discussion a motion was made by Alan Treinen to table the purchasing of new chairs to check into other places to purchase, 2nd by Robert Davis – motion carried.
