

## TOWN OF WEST POINT

The town board of the Town of West Point held a special meeting with the City of Lodi, the Town of Lodi and the Lodi Ambulance Commission on Tuesday, March 28<sup>th</sup>, 2000 at the Lodi Ambulance building at 7 p.m. The meeting was posted in three places in the Town of West Point.

Present was Fred Thistle – Chairman, Alan Treinen 1<sup>st</sup> Supervisor, and Robert Davis 2<sup>nd</sup> Supervisor. Also present was Edith Eberle – Town Clerk.

The Lodi Ambulance Commission announced that Diane Ebert is the new EMS director. She was not present as she is on vacation. Alan Treinen President of the Lodi Ambulance Commission asked Phil Brereton to explain the process on which the new director was hired. Phil Brereton explained that the new director is for organization and another person will be hired for the billing/insurance.

Fred Thistle – chairman for the Town of West Point brought up the two different titles for the Lodi Ambulance:

1. Lodi Community EMS Commission
2. Lodi Area EMS Commission

The two titles were discussed and it the thought that in 1972 when the Fire and Ambulance department separated that was when the change occurred. It was decided that the Ambulance Commission should work on changed the name legally and present to each of the municipalities at the fall meeting.

The Lodi Ambulance has about 300 calls per year and about 20 to 25 people on the ambulance service.

The Lodi Fire Department is working on purchasing the Cook property next to the Association Bank. They are having the property appraised and the Cook's will also have the property appraised. Also the Associated Bank has been asked to enter in a written agreement on what are presently the banks parking lot would be exchanged for the Cook property, so the Lodi Fire Department would have room to expand.

A motion was made by Robert Davis to adjourn the meeting at 8:15 p.m., 2<sup>nd</sup> by Fred Thistle – motion carried.
