

TOWN OF WEST POINT

Pursuant to Wisconsin State Statute 19.84, the Town Board of the Town of West Point held a special town board meeting on Monday, September 18th, 2000 at 8:00 p.m. at the Town of Roxbury town hall. The meeting was published in the Lodi Enterprise and the Sauk Prairie Star and posted in 3 places.

The town board members present were: Fred Thistle – town chairman, and Alan Treinen – 1st supervisor, Robert Davis – 2nd Supervisor, John Benish – 3rd Supervisor, and Torrey Latham – 4th Supervisor. Also present was Edith Eberle – town clerk.

The agenda item is: High Water in Crystal Lake

The town board of the Town of West Point and the town board of Town of Roxbury discussed different options – on high water levels – funds to pump Crystal Lake and applying for funds with Department of Natural Resources.

Mr. Tom Gaukel stated that there is a study being done now by the Department of Natural Resources on why the water is raising.

It was decided to ask both Dane County and Columbia County for money to be put into each of their 2001 budgets to help with the water problem in Crystal Lake. Each Town Board Town Chairman's and both Town Clerk's to get together on Wednesday, September 20, 2000 to work on a resolution that both Towns would consider adopting at their October meetings, to be sent to the Governor, Senator's (State and Federal), Representative (State and Federal), Dane County Board, Columbia County Board, Department of Natural Resources and any other people that could help the towns in receiving and/or applying for grants etc.

A motion was made by Alan Treinen to adjourn the meeting at 9:00 p.m., 2nd by Torrey Latham – motion carried.
