

TOWN OF WEST POINT

A public hearing for the 2001 budget was held on Tuesday, November 14, 2000 at 7:30 p.m. at the Town Hall. 12 residents and 2 non-residents were present. The public hearing was published in the Sauk Prairie Star and the Lodi Enterprise and posted in four places. A copy of the summary of the proposed budget was posted in four places.

The budget was explained and questions were answered.

The budget hearing was adjourned at 8:10 p.m.

The special town meeting was called to order at 8:10 p.m. by the town chairperson Fred Thistle. The meeting was published in the Sauk Prairie Star and the Lodi Enterprise and posted in four places.

The town board asked the town elector for permission to borrow \$300,000.00 to do town roads. Golf Road was stated that it needed to be looked at and up graded to State standards. The town board is considering upgrading Reynolds Road and Chrisler Road. It was asked if Eugene Hahn could help the Town of West Point to receive money from the State of Wisconsin for the Highway 12 project. After more discussion on town roads a motion was made by Richard O'Connor to grant the town board permission to borrow \$300,000.00 to do which ever roads the town board feels necessary, 2nd by Joyce Sinkule – yes 12, no 0 - motion carried.

Discussion on town officer's wages was brought up for discussion. A motion was made by Doug Richmond to raise the town clerk's salary from \$12,000.00 to \$15,000.00 and to raise the town treasurer from \$6,000.00 to \$7,000.00, 2nd by Joyce Sinkule Yes-12, no 0 – motion carried.

The proposed 2001 highway expenditures are \$199,547.50. A motion was made by Richard O'Connor to approve \$199,547.50 for highway expenditures, 2nd by Doug Richmond – yes 12, no 0 – motion carried.

A motion was made by Edie Klamer to adopt the Town of West Point tax levy of \$290,218.69 for 2001, 2nd by Richard O'Connor – yes 11, no 0 – motion carried.


