

TOWN OF WEST POINT

Pursuant to Wisconsin State Statute 19.84, the Town Board of the Town of West Point held a special town board meeting on Wednesday, January 17, 2000 at 7:15 p.m. at the West Point town hall. The meeting was published in the Lodi Enterprise and the Sauk Prairie Star and posted in 3 places.

The town board members present were: Fred Thistle – town chairman, and Alan Treinen – 1st supervisor, Robert Davis – 2nd supervisor, John Benish – 3rd supervisor, and Torrey Latham – 4th supervisor. Also present was Edith Eberle – town clerk.

On the agenda is the Ordinance for Regulate Boating or Use of Watercraft upon the Waters of Gruber's Grove Bay, Lake Wisconsin and Prescribing Penalties for Violation Thereof. The Ordinance will be in effect from March 1, 2001 to November 1, 2001. The Town of West Point is responsible for placing and maintaining a copy of Section IV at all public access points within the jurisdiction of the Town of West Point.

The town clerk stated that she had a letter from Attorney Clark that he had reviewed the retyped ordinance and found it acceptable.

A motion was made by John Benish to adopt the Ordinance #1/17/01, 2nd by Torrey Latham – motion carried.
